Report LOB Percentage by March 19

KSA <u>72-5143</u> requires **all school districts** to submit a written notice for local option budget (LOB) to the state board by **April 1** of the current school year. Such notice shall include the local option budget authority expressed as a percentage of the school district's total foundation aid. *The board of education shall not adopt a local option budget in excess of the authority stated in the form submitted* to KSDE *pursuant to this subsection*.

This reporting requirement does not replace the requirement for the board to adopt a resolution subject to protest petition in order to exceed 31% authority (maximum 33%) or the current authority a USD has obtained in a past year. If a board is considering an increase in their percentage by publishing for additional authority, they should submit the proposed percentage on the form submitted to KSDE.

The Local Option Budget Percentage web form (access through LEA Forms) will be considered your written notice of such intent for the upcoming school year. Link: LOB Percentage Form User's Guide
