

## Three-Year Monitoring Cycle Cohorts

The Kansas State Department of Education's Special Education and Title Services team uses the following three-year cohorts for the listed monitorings:

- Alternative Placement Monitoring
- ESEA Consolidated Review
- Federal Fiscal File Review
- IDEA and Gifted Requirements File Review

With the following notes:

- Alternative Placement Monitoring: Public school districts with an adult detention center (county jail), juvenile detention center, or facility that receives Title Neglected or Delinquent funding within district boundaries must participate in Alternative Placement Monitoring. State Hospital Training Center Parsons and Kansas Department of Corrections must also participate in Alternative Placement Monitoring.
- ESEA Consolidated Review: Organizations that received Title funds in the previous school year in which the organization is listed in a cohort will be included in the ESEA Consolidated Review. If an organization is listed in a cohort that did not receive Title funds in the previous school year it will not be included in the ESEA Consolidated Review.
- Federal Fiscal File Review: Organizations that received federal funds must complete Federal Fiscal File Review. This includes all of the public school districts, service centers, State Hospital Training Center Parsons, Kansas State School for the Deaf, Kansas State School for the Blind and the Kansas Department of Corrections. Federal Fiscal File Review includes skip logic to allow for an organization to pass over categories of questions that do not apply.
- IDEA and Gifted Requirements File Review: All public school districts, Kansas Department of Corrections, State Hospital Training Center Parsons, Kansas State School for the Deaf, and Kansas State School for the Blind must complete IDEA and Gifted Requirements File Review monitoring in the relevant cohort year.
