2024 USD Budget Workshops

Budget workshops are conducted for superintendents, clerks, and business managers of unified school districts. The 2024-25 budget document will be reviewed, and we will discuss the new school finance bills passed by the 2024 Legislature. Please invite your county clerk and school auditor (CPA) to attend a workshop. Board members or officers of your teachers' association are also welcome.

USD BUDGET CHANGES FOR 2024:

Several school finance bills passed by the 2024 Legislature will affect the USD budget in the upcoming school year. We will focus on four areas:

- 1. Enrollment count for funding: Starting in 2024-25, enrollment will be determined by using the highest FTE of the following: (a) current year, (b) prior year, or (c) average of preceding two years. Starting in 2025-26, enrollment will be the highest of (a) or (b), and (c) is removed.
- 2. **At-risk Program**: (a) new At-Risk Pilot Program starts; and (b) caveats within the At-risk program that will need to be addressed by all USDs.
- 3. **Special Education state aid**: A portion of special education funding will be distributed using a new formula.
- 4. **Required LOB transfer**: USDs will be required to transfer a portion of LOB funds to the Special Education Fund.
