The following form must be completed by districts that carried over funds on the FY 2021 LCP Revision and Carryover:

- *FY 2022 LCP Carryover Final Expenditure Report* (web-based; districts will be notified when this form is available to complete) – **due October 16, 2023**

The following forms will be emailed to LCP contacts **if** they are **applicable** to your district:

- *FY 2022 Rural, Low-Income Grant Carryover Final Project Expenditure Report* – **due October 16, 2023**
- *FY 2023 Rural, Low-Income Grant Final Project Expenditure Report* – **due January 15, 2024**
