# IDEA PART D PROGRAM PURPOSE

- State Personnel Development Plan
- Assist State Education Agencies in reforming and improving systems for personnel preparation and professional development for individuals providing early intervention, education, and transition services to improve results for children with disabilities.



# BACKGROUND

- ➤ IDEA statute requires each state to develop a State Personnel Development Plan
- Competitive State Personnel Development Grants (SPDG) first offered in 1999
- Kansas SPDG focus: High quality training systems that build district capacity to support & sustain evidence-based instructional practices



### GRANT REQUIREMENTS

- Grant proposals must address a critical unmet need
- > 90% of the grant funds must be spent on professional development activities
- No more than 10% of the funds can be spent on state activities
- Requires rigorous monitoring and performance measures (KU Center for Research and Learning; Gaumer-Erickson and Noonan)



### 2017-2022 KANSAS SPDG

The overarching goal of the Kansas SPDG is to improve resilience and achievement of children and adolescents with disabilities and their peers through the sustained implementation of systematic tiered levels of evidence-based mental health interventions.

### YEARS ONE - THREE

An interconnected system of School Mental Health (SMH) will be enacted and refined across five representative Kansas communities.

Two communities will be larger urban Kansas communities and three will be rural regions that encompass multiple districts, an estimated total of 15 districts.



### YEARS FOUR AND FIVE

- The five supported Kansas communities will become SMH models to assist with statewide implementation.
- KS SMH model communities, including administrators, teachers, school- and community-based mental health providers, and family members, will become regional mentors.
- Ten regional systems-level coaches will be trained to build district capacity to implement the SMH tiered system with fidelity.

#### **GOAL**

By the end of Year 5, all districts and communities in Kansas will have access to evidence-based resources, protocols, processes, and professional learning that are effective in meeting the mental health needs of students.
