S Endorsement for CDL Holders

AN "S" ENDORSEMENT IS REQUIRED ON A CDL FOR THE OPERATION OF A SCHOOL BUS.

Why an "S" Endorsement?

 The U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) issued on July 31, 2002, a final rule that significantly strengthens the licensing and sanctioning requirements of the commercial driver's license (CDL). The rule was effective September 30, 2002. Within three years after the rule's effective date, FMCSA will penalize states that are not in substantial compliance with the licensing and sanctioning requirements. 	 Kansas Statutes Annotated 8-2, 135 To comply with FMCSA requirements, the Kansas legislature passed HB 2220 in April 2003. Among other things, this bill requires an "S" endorsement on a commercial driver's license for operation of a school bus.
"S" Endorsement Requirements	Fees
 An applicant for a school bus endorsement must satisfy the following three requirements: 	 Kansas DMV offices that provide CDL testing will issue new "S" endorsements on CDL licenses.
1) Hold a passenger vehicle endorsement.	 CDL licenses may be renewed one year prior to expiration
2) Must pass a special school bus knowledge test.	
 Must take a driving skills test in a school bus of the same vehicle group as the school bus applicant will drive; skills test includes a vehicle pre-trip inspection, control maneuvers, and a road test. 	 Total Fee \$10.00 "S" endorsement \$3.00 Examination fee \$8.00 Photo fee

Written Exam

- <u>ALL</u> "S" endorsement applicants must pass a special school bus written examination.
- The knowledge test will cover:
 - Loading and unloading children
 - Emergency exits
 - Rail road crossings
- The test will consist of multiple choice questions that are randomly generated from a pool of approved questions.
- 80% and above is a passing score.
- This is a closed book knowledge test.

- The written examination is solely derived from the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrator's, Model CDL Manual (revised 12-2005) approved by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration.
- Knowledge test material is derived from the <u>Kansas</u> <u>School of Transportation, Regulations, Standards,</u> <u>Statutes, and Guidelines</u>. This publication can be viewed in its entirety on the School Bus Safety Unit website at <u>http://www.ksde.org/Default.aspx?tabid=117</u>.
- The test material will be derived from the Kansas CDL manual which is approved by FMCSA.

Study Material for the Knowledge Test

- All questions on the "S" Endorsement written test will be taken from a 4-page study manual. An "S" endorsement study pamphlet will be available at all DMV state examining locations; or
