(D)(5) Indicator – Secondary Schools

(D)(5) Indicator: The number and identity of the schools that are secondary schools that are eligible for, but do not receive, Title I funds that are identified as persistently lowest-achieving schools.

Initially, the definition for identifying secondary schools as persistently lowest-achieving only included those schools that were eligible for Title I but did not receive Title I funds. Since then, the US Department of Education is permitting states to request waivers from the US Department of Education which expanded the pool of secondary schools to include schools that are also eligible and receiving Title I funds. Kansas requested that waiver; therefore, the following list of secondary schools include both those receiving Title I funds and those that are eligible but do not receive funds. The schools are listed according to USD number.
