There are 36 Title I schools in Kansas that are in improvement, corrective action or restructuring in 2010-2011. Twenty-nine of these schools are on improvement for mathematics. The 18 schools showing progress represent 62% of the Title I schools on improvement, corrective action or restructuring in mathematics.
