- 3 of 4 changed for 2023-2026
 - Significant changes:
 - Network Systems
 - Information Service & Support
 - Some changes:
 - Programming & Software Development
 - General: addition of Cybersecurity I and II as Application level
 - General: addition of Work-based Learning as Application level
- Web & Digital Communications: no changes



NS & ISS

- Introductory Level:
 - No change
- Technical Level:
 - Removed all technical courses
 - Replaced with 10001 Foundations of IT (required course)
- Application Level:
 - Removed all existing courses
 - Added Cybersecurity I (no prereq) and Cybersecurity II (prereq CS I)
 - NS: added NS I (prereq 10001) and NS II (prereq NS I)
 - ISS: Added ISS I (prereq 10001) and ISS II (prereq ISS I)
 - Added Work-based Learning course



Programming & Software Development

- Relatively minor changes
- Introductory level: no changes
- Technical level: no changes
- Application level:
 - Remove Cybersecurity, replace with Cybersecurity I (no prereq) and Cybersecurity II (prereq Cybersecurity I)
 - Keep CS-A and IB Computing
 - Replace PM course with WBL course



Web & Digital Communications

- Moved to Graphic Design and AV portion of cluster
- Work is under way and likely to be considered by KACCTE in summer meeting
