Why has my district's allocation changed?

- 1) Federal funding for SY 2017 has remained constant.
- 2) Allocations are required by the federal government to be calculated with the most recent census data available. SY 2017 allocations were calculated using 2014 Census estimates, while SY 2018 will be calculated using the 2015 US Census. Districts will see large variances in funding if the census reflects a large variance in ages 5-17 residents.
- 3) This estimate includes all districts eligible for Perkins funding in the 2016 - 2017 school year as of July 1, 2016.
- 4) As pathways continue to develop, funding will be more widespread throughout the state as federal contribution remains constant.
