

## TASN RFA Q & A

### Questions posed during the KSDE TASN RFA Webinar held June 6, 2014

**Q.** Does the 50 page limit apply to all priority areas?

**A.** The 50 page limit applies to each competition within a priority area. There are a total of 12 separate competitions listed (see page 4 of the RFA). Each application submitted in a competition is allowed a maximum of 50 pages. A single application cannot contain more than one priority or sub-priority.

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**Q.** Will a list of letters of intent be publicly available for collaboration purposes?

**A.** A list of letters of intent will not be publicly available in order to ensure fairness in the bidding process. Applicants are encouraged to seek out partners that meet the specifications within the priorities.

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**Q.** In the plan of operation template, what is to be entered in the cells labeled Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 cells?

**A.** This might be some type of symbol, such as an X, that would indicate the activity would be occurring and/or re-occurring over the course of 5 years. The cell labeled “Timeline” is where a specific date or month would be entered.

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#### Priority 7a: Co-Teaching funding amount:

**Q.** Which is the correct year three through five dollar amount for co-teaching? The year three through five dollar amount in the RFA table (page 4) is different than the amount listed in the priority description on page 13.

**A.** There is an error in year 3-5 amount in the table on page 4 of the RFA. \$415,000 is the correct amount. The amount on page 13 is correct. The competition amount for years 1 and 2 is lower than years 3-5 because Keystone Learning Services is currently awarded funding from the State Personnel Development Grant (SPDG) through September 30, 2017. Prospective applicants will need to work closely with Keystone Learning Services to design and carryout the outcomes of Priority 7a for years one and two.
