Count Date: Wednesday, September 20, 2023

K.S.A. 72-5132 designates September 20 as enrollment count day, the date that is used to determine the number of students regularly enrolled for funding purposes. If the 20th is not a school day, the count day moves to the first school day following the 20th. Please set your calendar so that classes are in session for all enrolled students. Avoid scheduling staff training or parent-teacher conferences on the official student count date.

Students should be enrolled and attending on the official count date, Wed. Sept 20.

A school district's General Fund Budget is determined by taking the district's total adjusted weighted enrollment, times the base aid for student excellence (BASE). For 2023-24, the BASE is \$5,088.

We encourage you to review the School Term guideline document, "1,116 Hours School Year Requirement," on the School Finance homepage at this link: Guidelines and Manuals. This annual school term requirement must be met by school districts for state aid and accreditation purposes. Use the guideline document to help determine the common activities which can and cannot be counted towards the school term requirement. The document includes a summary of state law, recordkeeping requirements and explains the inclement weather/snow day provision.

Directory Updates (Grades Offered)

Beginning 2023-2024 school year, Kansas Individual Data on Students (KIDS) has realigned **D10 Current Grade Level** to more accurately correspond to the actual student grade level. This information can be found on Page 20 of the <u>KIDS File Specifications</u>. All preschool-aged student records will be now be submitted as **PR = Preschool** and other student level data fields will be used to determine if they are funded as preschool aged with IEP, or 3-yr-old at-risk (previously Grade 33) or 4-yr-old at-risk (previously Grade 04).

The Directory Updates **Grades Offered** still reflects the original preschool grades as reflected below. As a result of the KIDS grade **PR** validating against Directory Updates **Grades Offered**, <u>all</u> preschool aged grades <u>must</u> be selected in the Directory Updates web application in order to upload any KIDS record with D10 Current Grade Level as PR for that specific school building.



To confirm whether your elementary school building has each of the four preschoolaged grades selected, please login the KSDE Authentication web application: https://apps.ksde.org/authentication/login.aspx

- 1. Select Directory Updates
- 2. Select "Buildings (Schools & Programs)" from the left menu
- 3. Locate the elementary school building in the box located in the top right corner of the screen and click "Select"
- 4. Scroll down to Grades Offered and select any preschool-aged grade that is not already checked

This application is open year-round and <u>does not require KSDE to un-submit</u> if changes are needed to the Grades Offered. Once changes are made, click SAVE at the top or bottom of the screen, and all updates will be saved.

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
