

EVIDENCE COLLECTION PLANNER

Guidance: During the evidence collection day we will be checking the progress of your implementation. Each 3-hour onsite visit should include the following components.

Feedback Planning (Complete during Day 1 Show and Launch)

Target participants in feedback collection during school visit (teachers, students, community, parents, etc...)

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Format for feedback collection (group interview, 1:1s, other?)

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Questions, themes or trends you would like to ask of participants

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How will you plan to capture (i.e. notes document, video recording, etc...) and share the evidence that you observed? (Note: you will need to be able to link this evidence into your redesign planner)

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DEBRIE
