Kansas Preschool Pilot Grant Applications due Jan. 15

The 2024-2025 Kansas Preschool Pilot (KPP) Grant Requirements and Application is now available. As a current Kansas Preschool Pilot grantee, you will have the opportunity to renew your current level of funding through a quick, noncompetitive process. As in years past, you will complete a short Qualtrics application along with the Preschool Revenue Calculator and Budget Template tool to estimate preschool revenue and expenditures for next school year. If the gap between expected revenues and expenditures remains larger than or equal to your current grant award, you can expect to receive level funding. If other sources of funding will reduce the gap between revenue and expenditures, you can expect to receive a grant equal to the size of that gap.

Grant applications are due at 5:00 p.m. Monday, January 15. Note that January 15 is Martin Luther King Jr. Day; KSDE staff will be unavailable to answer questions after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 12.

The amount of Kansas Preschool Pilot grant funding available statewide remains limited. Districts are encouraged to consider other larger, more sustainable options to invest in preschool. If any available 2024-2025 Kansas Preschool Pilot funds remain following the review of renewal grant applications, KSDE will review applications for new awards of up to \$50,000 on a competitive basis.
