Special Education Transportation (Form 308) due today

Reminder: <u>All</u> LEAs need to submit Form 308 and provide encumbered transportation costs through June 30. *If there are <u>no</u> expenses to report, go online to enter <u>\$0</u> special education transportation costs and submit this report anyway.*

Our records indicate that 60 districts, interlocals and special education cooperatives have <u>not started</u> the Form 308 needed to calculate the June 1 special education state aid payment. We have received 188 completed reports, and 58 reports are in progress.

State aid deposits May 14 for National Board Certified Teachers

The state aid payment for the National Board Certified Teacher incentive bonus will direct deposit on Friday, May 14. This payment shall be deposited in the general fund (Code 06) and is considered reimbursement to the district.

National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification Initiative K.S.A. 72-2166

A teacher employed by a Kansas school district who has attained National Board certification will be paid an incentive bonus of \$1,000. The bonus is paid each school year as long as the teacher remains employed by a Kansas school district and retains a valid master teacher's certificate. The bonus is paid by the employing school district, but the school district is entitled to receive state aid under the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification Incentive Program equal to the amount of any bonuses paid.

Payment will be allocated to 39 school districts and 2 special ed coops that submitted a claim for eligible teachers.
