

This *Letter of Intent* **does not obligate** the local school district to hire a teacher from **Spain**. It helps the KSDE coordinator find the most suitable candidate(s) for your district to interview in the initial screening process.

If after submitting this application, you decide not to pursue hiring an international teacher, please notify KSDE. No guarantee can be made to fill the position for which the district is requesting a teacher. Since all candidates experience a long and rigorous application process, withdrawing an offer of employment after the teacher has accepted is strongly discouraged. The hiring process should be conducted in the same professional manner as any other potential new hire.

There is program fee of \$2,000, but it will not be due until after the teacher has signed a teaching contract. KSDE will send your district an invoice in August.
