

# **Tiered Technical Courses**

# What are Tiered Technical/Excel in CTE Courses?

- ♣ Post-secondary credits first funded when Senate Bill 155, or the Governor's CTE bill, was passed into law on July 1, 2012.
- ♣ Provides free tuition or tuition reimbursement for high school students taking designated CTE courses from post-secondary institutions while in high school. ♣ The goal of this bill is to create a Kansas workforce that is highly skilled and ready for employment.
- Students may be financially responsible for fees outside of tuition including technology fees, tools, and textbooks.

# What are the benefits of students completing Tiered Technical / Excel in CTE courses?

- ♣ Of the students earning nine or more college credit hours while in high school, 88% continued in post-secondary education after high school. (Community College Research Center, 2017).
- Students who earn nine or more college credit hours can be considered a pathway completer if they have taken the correct sequence of courses for a pathway.
- ♣ Students who earn nine or more college credit hours will meet the requirement for postsecondary assets for graduation (starting with the Class of 2028). ♣ Schools often are
  not able to offer courses in each pathway. This allows students to pursue their pathway
  of interest, while earning college credit.
