PURPOSE OF AUDIT

State aid is based on documented LEA expenditures for program costs, which have been approved by KSDE. KSDE has been authorized to expend available funds for the purpose of serving pre-school children within the state of Kansas providing a qualified program of education for such children.

AUDIT STEPS

- 1. Validate reported program expenditures.
- 2. Determine whether state aid was expended to serve pre-school aged children.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Report expenditure deviations next to the reported budget amount on the application form.
- 2. Enter the claimed and audited expenditures for each line item reported.
- 3. Report claimed and audited entitlement on the Overall Audit Summary.
