

## 2015 Credential Incentive Report

The graduating class of 2015 was the third opportunity for schools/colleges to report the number of students who received professional certifications prior to graduating from high school, thus qualifying for the SB155 incentive moneys. Of the more than 30 certifications on the approved list, 2015 graduates earned a total of **1670 certifications** in seventeen areas. Twelve of the 2015 graduates earned two different certifications. The number of public school Districts participating has increased from 108 in 2013 to 173 in 2015.

The breakdown by certification is as follows:
