

2016 Credential Incentive Report

The graduating class of 2016 was the fourth opportunity for schools/colleges to report the number of students who received professional certifications prior to graduating from high school, thus qualifying for the SB155 incentive moneys. Of the more than 30 certifications on the approved list, 2016 graduates earned a total of **1597 certifications** in seventeen areas.

The breakdown by certification is as follows:
