Transfer & Credit for Prior Learning Resources



The Kansas Board of Regents has approved 100+ <u>System Wide Transfer (SWT)</u> <u>courses</u>. A student who successfully completes any of these courses at a Kansas public university, community college, or technical college will be able to transfer the course to any Kansas public postsecondary institution offering an equivalent course.

<u>Credit for Prior Learning</u> (CPL) refers to a process used by post-secondary institutions to award academic credit for a student's knowledge and expertise acquired through life and professional experience, as long as the student's knowledge and skills are determined to be equivalent to college-level learning.

College Credit for Prior Learning Advanced Placement, College-Level Exam Program, International Baccalaureate, military experience are common types of CPL for which college credit is awarded at institutions.
