14 is the magic number!!!

- Every driver's ed student must:
 - Be age 14 on the first day of class
 - Turn 14 within **2 days of the first day of class**
 - No exceptions

3 Wheel Classes

- Circle “Motorcycle” and “Yes” on the 3 Wheel question on the Certificate of Completion when teaching a 3 Wheel class.

DE-99 Parent Guardian Permit

- Issued after the student passes the written handbook test. You should be encouraging the student to make their exam office appointment once they pass and be issued their IP.
- Issuance and expiration dates are on the Permit.
- **Valid for use as a driving credential** as long as an adult driver, who meets all statutory requirements, is in the front seat.
- Should be turned in to the Division of Vehicles during driver education class to have a hard copy IP issued to begin the year requirement.
- If not turned in to the DOV, it must be returned to the instructor when receiving the Certificate of Completion and there is no driving until their IP is issued.

Vision Questions – Why are there two?

- The **first vision question** determines if the restriction for **Corrective Lenses** must be added to the Permit/License.
- The **second vision question** at the end of the application **determines if a vision exam is required based on the acuity of each eye** and when the last vision exam occurred.
- If the student has a valid Division of Vehicles issued Permit what do you enter as acuity?
