Qualifications for Motorcycle Instructor Course Candidates

Candidates must:

1. Have a valid Driver's license with a motorcycle endorsement
2. Be at least 18 years of age
3. Possess a clean driving record (which includes no felonies, DUI's, or misdemeanors within the last 3 years and have no more than 2 moving violations within a 2-year period/or violation free for 12 months)
4. Have successfully completed a beginning rider course, has successfully completed a 60-hour instructor's course approved by the state board.
5. It is recommended that candidate owns his/her own motorcycle.

Qualifications for Motorcycle Chief Instructor Course Candidates

Candidates must:

1. Have a valid Driver's license with a motorcycle endorsement
2. Be at least 21 years of age
3. Possess a clean driving record {which includes no felonies, DUI's, or misdemeanors within the last 3 years and have no more than 2 moving violations within a 2-year period/or violation free for 12 months}
4. Have successfully completed an approved Kansas Instructor's course
5. Pass a riding evaluation given by a current Kansas Chief Instructor
6. Have taught 3 Kansas motorcycle courses within the last 2 years
7. Each motorcycle instructor permit and each chief instructor permit shall be valid for three years (unless the person holding the permit has either of the following:
(A) Two or more moving traffic violations during the validity period of the permit; or
(B) a conviction of any of the crimes specified in paragraph...)
8. Own his/her own motorcycle

Requirements to renew

Candidates must:

1. Has taught at least one beginning rider's course each year, if an instructor, or at least one instructor's course during the past three years, if a chief instructor;
2. has taught at least one motorcycle riding course each year; and
3. has no more than two moving traffic violations within the past three years and no conviction of any of the traffic violations specified in K.S.A. 8-254 and amendments thereto.
