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## PRESIDENTIALSCHOLARSINFORMATION SHEET

The Presidential Scholars Program was established by President Lyndon Johnson in 1964 and has since honored more than 7,000 outstanding high school seniors. The mission of the program is to recognize and honor superior high school seniors and thereby encourage high attainment among all students.
Each state has been asked to nominate up to 20 students, ten male and ten female. Students nominated must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and must show promise of continued achievement.
In order to be eligible to be nominated a student must meet all of the following criteria:

## Federal Eligibility Criteria

- Be scheduled to graduate from a public or private secondary school during the 2021-2022 school year.
- Be a citizen or national of the United States or an alien lawfully admitted to the United States forpermanent residence.
- Have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and must show promise of continuedachievement.


## State Eligibility Criteria

- A six -semester, unweighted grade point average of 3.85 , based on a 4.0 system. Please be sure the reported GPA conforms to the 4.0 system.
- Have a composite score of 30 or more on the ACT Assessment or a score of 1300 or more on the SAT.


## APPLICATION FORMAT

## NO COVER PAGE

- Type - Do not use anything smaller than 11 pt type . Nominations which are not typed or computergenerated will not be considered.
- Page one is the completed and signed application form. MUST be typed or word processed.
- Pages two and three are the completed academic information/honors forms. MUST be typed.
- Pages four and five school/community involvement and leadership. MUST be typed.
- Attach an official six-semester transcript to the application (an official transcript must be signed by a school official and have a raised seal or stamp on it). Also provide three additional copies of the transcript.
- Be sure that the ACT record is current on the transcript.

The original application and three copies of the entire application packet MUST BE SUBMITTED IN A SINGLE PACKET.
NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be considered for review.
Schools may nominate up to one student per school.
