- State Plan – Tate Toedman
 - Revised Template for the Consolidated State Plan is posted on website for council. <http://www.ksde.org/Agency/Division-of-Learning-Services/Early-Childhood-Special-Education-and-Title-Services/Title-Services/ESEA>
 - The Kansas plan will be posted on August 1 for public comment.
 - Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) and Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) schools will be identified.
 - Universal Support and Improvement (USI) schools will be all schools not identified in any other category.
- AMOSS – Beth Fultz
 - Handouts of Fact sheets
 - 3rd year of administering the Kansas Assessments
 - Next year an additional predictive assessment will be available
 - Assessment tools are being reviewed.
 - Use the sample tests to help students become familiar with the testing environment.
 - Students need to receive instruction with the same tools they use on the assessment.

 - Tate Toedman is the Ombudsman for Kansas. No carryover funds are allowed in the private school share.

 - KIAS is our Monitoring tool. This tool helps us determine where to provide technical assistance to support student improvement.
 - 3 year cycle for monitoring.
 - Technical assistance focuses on collaboration with district leaders to provide assistance in areas needed to help the district move forward.
