## CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION WEIGHTING (KSA 72-5155)

The Kansas School Equity and Enhancement Act (KSEEA), as enacted, includes a career technical education (CTE) weighting. The weighting is calculated by multiplying the Full Time Equivalency (FTE) enrollment (CTE contact hours divided by 6) in approved CTE programs by a factor of 0.5. No amendments have been made to the weighting since the enactment of the KSEEA.
