The following guidelines should be used to determine "full time equivalency" (FTE):

FTE for licensed administrators, teachers and other licensed (certified) personnel is defined by the local school board.

Generally, 1.0 FTE is reported as:

- o teachers with a 9-10 month contract
- o principals with a 10-12 month contract
- superintendents with a 12 month contract

For the current school year, ESTIMATE the number of employees and salaries.

> FTE for 1.0 for non-licensed administrators and classified personnel should be based upon 2,080 hours.
