- Other information: Sources of Revenue, FTE enrollment, mill rates, assessed valuations, and bonded indebtedness.

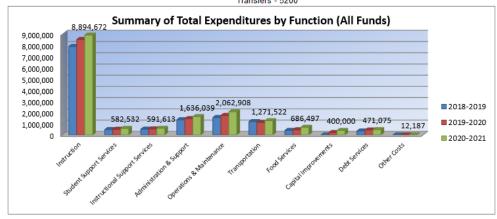
