A teacher employed by a Kansas school district who has attained National Board certification shall be paid an incentive bonus of \$1,000. The bonus is paid each school year as long as the teacher remains employed by a Kansas school district and retains a valid master teacher's certificate. The bonus shall be paid by the employing school district, but the school district is entitled to receive state aid under the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Certification Incentive Program equal to the amount of any bonuses paid. The state aid is to be deposited in the school district general fund and treated as a reimbursement.
