Nancy Schulz Safety Award Criteria

The following are items for your use in selecting your nominee to KSPTA awards committee and will be considered by the committee for determining a recipient:

- **Increase Employee Safety Awareness**
Made significant contributions to bring safety to the attention of others within the company or district.
- **Made Substantial Contributions to Safety in the Transportation Department**
Created a safety awareness campaign or other such program within the company or district.
- **Enhanced the safety of others**
Created awareness within the district or company of safety hazards and offered suggestions to eliminate such hazards.
- **Demonstrated Safety Leadership**
Raised safety issues, concerns or improvement ideas to others within the company or district.
- **Prevented an accident or injury**
Recognized an immediate hazard to a fellow employee, warned fellow employees and administration of such hazard thus eliminating such unsafe act from happening in the future.
