To Whom It May Concern:

The holder of this document is employed by a Kansas Unified School District as a School/Activity Bus or School Vehicle Driver and **has not** selected category #1 or #3 on his or her Commercial Driver's License Medical Self-Certification. This person is required to have a physical/medical exam which meets physical standards required by Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Regulation 49 CFR 391.41.

This physical/medical exam is required by Kansas Statute Annotated 8-2009 and Kansas Administrative Regulation 91-38-6. However, the medical examiner performing the medical exam/physical **is not** required to be on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's National Medical Registry per an exemption for political subdivisions found in 49 CFR 390.3.

The medical examiner performing this physical/medical exam is to use the following forms as prescribed by the Kansas State Department of Education:

- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Medical Examiners Report form MCSA 5875 or Kansas State Department of Education form SBSU\_MER
- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Medical Examiners Certificate MCSA 5876 or Kansas State Department of Education form SBSU\_MEC (copy must be provided to the driver for employer records)
