

## BILINGUAL WEIGHTING (KSA 72-5150)



The Kansas School Equity and Enhancement Act (KSEEA) includes a bilingual weighting. As enacted, the weighting provides two options for calculating a school district's bilingual weighting. A district's weighting is the greater of either:

- FTE enrollment (contact hours divided by 6) in approved bilingual education programs x 0.395; or
- Headcount enrollment in approved bilingual education programs x 0.185.

No amendments have been made to the bilingual weighting since the enactment of the KSEEA.
