Update: Using CARES Act funds for food service expenses

One of the allowable uses for CARES Act (*ESSER) funds is paying for food service expenses created by the COVID-19 school closure. If your district chooses to use these funds for that purpose, you will report those expenditures on the USD Budget in Code 07-Federal Funds and charge to Function 3100-Food Service Operations.

To request ESSER grant funds, submit the <u>Form 240 web application</u> by the 20th of the month. Form 240 questions: Nicole Norwood <u>nnorwood@ksde.org</u>

Reminders:

- When you complete the Monthly/Annual Financial Report in KN-Claim, remember to include CARES Act Funding as a revenue in Section 4000 (Other Federal Grant).
- For audit purposes, school districts will need to create a new CARES fund/account within your local accounting system to track expenditures separately within the Code 07-Federal Funds.
- The Federal Cash Management Act requires that federal funds must be spent by the end of the month in which they are received. *LEAs cannot carry over federal funds to the following month.*

*ESSER - Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief (federal CARES Act)

The 2019-20 Kansas Parent as Teachers Final Expense Claim web application will open by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 19</u>. Please <u>submit claim by Friday</u>, <u>May 29</u>, to allow KSDE staff adequate time to process the payment. Login to <u>Authenticated Application link</u> and open <u>LEA Forms</u> and then select: <u>Parents as Teachers-KPEP</u>.

Once the web app is available to enter data, we will email <u>instructions</u> to the following KSDE listservs: *PAT coordinators, superintendents and board clerks*
