PRE-KINDERGARTEN

A pre-kindergarten program is an academic program for children under age five that is operated very similar to a school program. Children in this program are not counted in the school finance formula. Children in a 4-year-old at risk program that has been approved by the State Board of Education or 3, 4 and 5-year-old special education children with an IEP are not included in the Pre-Kindergarten numbers.
