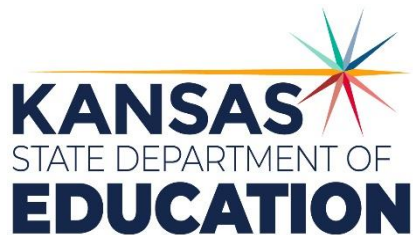

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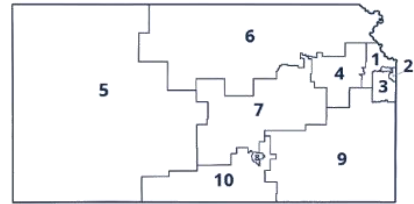

Introduction

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This publication has been prepared by the School Finance Team of the Kansas State Department of Education to provide selected data related to the average salaries for classroom teachers for each of the unified school districts in Kansas. You may download the report in Excel format and sort as desired.

This data is compiled from the annual Superintendent's Organization Report, which was submitted by the unified school districts. Please note that there is a wide disparity in years of teaching experience, college hours of personnel, and budget per pupil, which would account for disparities in salaries between school districts.
