**AFI 7.2:** Assessment 4 does not align with Standard 7.

**Rationale 7.2:** Assessment 4, Task 4 (including IV.D.) does not utilize language of the Standard. The description mentions professional development, but does not convincingly guarantee fulfillment of the Standard. To clarify the problem, the first sentence on page 17 in regard to ALIGNMENT WITH KSDE STANDARDS - Standard 7 (“During mentorship...”) is begging the question (i.e., the logical fallacy, not the colloquial misuse). There is no evidence in that sentence to suggest that the Standard has been met; instead, the sentence states that the Standard has been met and then restates the premise (i.e., the requirements). The following sentence, which is the site of contention, attempts to bolster/validate the claim by stating that candidates \*often\*

join NAEA and students \*may\* attend state or national conferences. This implies that some do not: that it is not required. In such cases the Standard would not be met (not even partially).
