~~AFI 5.1 The unit lacks sufficient evidence that professional education faculty members are actively engaged in scholarship. (Initial)~~

~~Rationale 5.1—Although both of the full-time faculty have either completed or are working toward a doctorate, minimal evidence of scholarship is found in the faculty vita. Opportunities are available for full-time faculty to publish research or present observations, only one of the full-time faculty has presented to a professional organization and only one has published an article. A review of part time/full time faculty vita revealed the professional scholarship is very dated or minimal in presentation.~~

2019 visit team recommendation: "We find that this AFI should be removed. This is no longer a specific standard for CAEP [KSDE] and there is clear evidence of scholarship."

~~AFI 6.1 The unit does not ensure all Teacher Education Committee members understand and function as a governing body. (Initial)~~

~~Rationale 6.1 The Teacher Education Committee (TEC) is the unit responsible for teacher education programs at Bethel College. There is limited understanding of the TEC as members of the "unit" decision making committee other than approving candidate entrance to the program, admittance to student teaching, and exit from the program. There is limited interaction across the college content faculty in identifying as part of the unit and developing, understanding, and applying the unit's conceptual framework and assessment system.~~

2019 visit team recommendation: "We find that this AFI should be removed. This is not a standard for CAEP [KSDE] and through new policy, the roles of governing bodies, including the TEC have been clarified."
